What is a Signature Project?

Signature projects show the impact a Kiwanis club can have on a community. From playgrounds and parks to festivals and fundraisers, signature projects are the hallmarks of what Kiwanis clubs are known for in their communities. This year, Kiwanis

International hosted the ninth annual Signature Project Recognition Program for clubs and districts. Clubs with 27 members or fewer were judged in the Group I category. Clubs with 28 members or more were judged in Group II. Each group was judged separately, and the top 10 finalists were determined for each group. The top three selections from each group were recognized as the gold, silver and bronze winners at the 2025 Kiwanis International Convention. The winning projects in each group were awarded US\$2,000, \$1,500 and \$1,000! Think about what your Kiwanis club is known for in your community. It can be a service project or a fundraiser. 65 years of Pancakes should qualify! Signature projects: **Are recurring. Enhance the Kiwanis image. Demonstrate significant impact on the community in terms of monies raised or children served.
