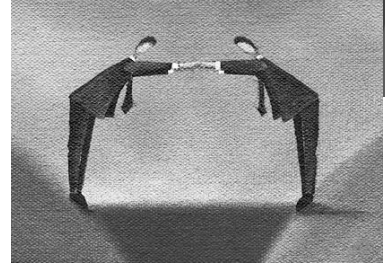
Early Education and Care - Kidfest
