The event is known as “Christmas in July” and the focus is to provide homeless children and their families with a day of games, activities, and shows. The pinnacle of the afternoon is a visit from Santa, who brings gifts of clothing, shoes, school supplies, and toys to these children. There will be more information on this project in the coming months, but I invite each of you to begin considering now how we can help support our incoming governor with her project.

***Kiwanis Colloge***

An interclub meeting is one that is jointly planned and held by two or more Kiwanis clubs, or by a Kiwanis club and any SLP Club, and duly announced as such in advance through club notices. No fewer than a visiting group of four people—composed of Kiwanians, or a minimum of two Kiwanians plus members of a SLP Club sponsored by the visiting Kiwanis club—must be in attendance. To qualify for interclub credit, the meeting must be an official meeting of the host club. Conventions, division council meetings and similar events do not normally qualify.

***We’re giving it away.....***

The best part of fundraising is when we get to give it back to the community. So, after a successful year, now is the time. We started the year with a new plan. First, to award a series of mini grants of \$500 each, which we have now given \$2,450 to 5 worthy organizations. Next, through an application process that ended on June 30<sup>th</sup>, distribute the remaining funds to community organizations that have developed

projects that best serve our area’s children and families. Those selected are: Salvation Army S.M.A.K. project (\$2,000), Merritt Brown’s Brown Bear Reading program (\$1,500), and Healthy Start Voucher Project (\$1,450). We’ll finalize the year by completing our Major Emphasis contribution to the Eliminate campaign totaling \$5,000. WOW! Your hard work has benefitted many and we look forward to next year.



**ASAP.....** This acronym can mean many things, but to us it is the After School Assistance Program. They are pursuing a much needed capital building project in which we have committed \$20,000 to give to them when they finally break ground. Hindered by government delays, they are now jumpstarting the fundraising again by having a ribbon-cutting on Aug. 13<sup>th</sup>. Listen for the details as we show our support.



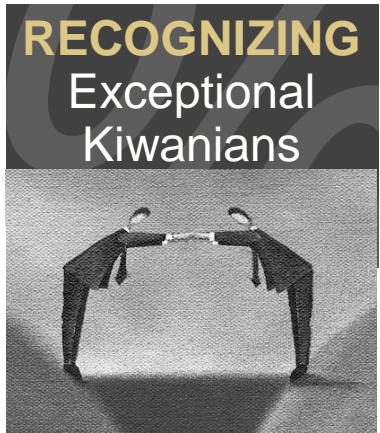

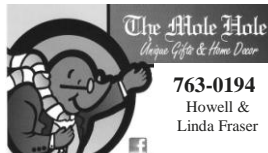
