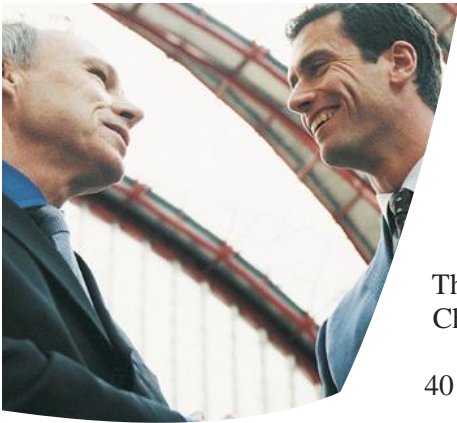

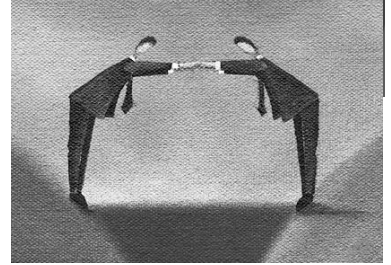
Thanks to all who made Christmas in November another success! 40 members and 2 guests placed bids totaling **\$1,774.50.**




