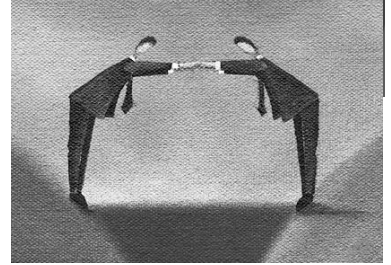
## Kiwanis Education
