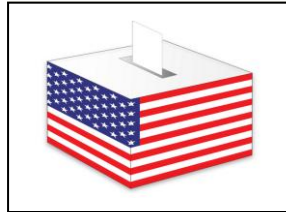
Kiwanis College

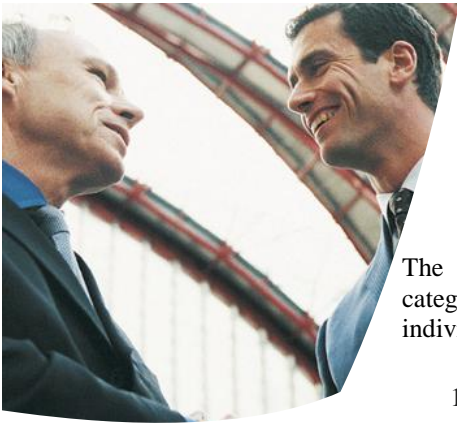

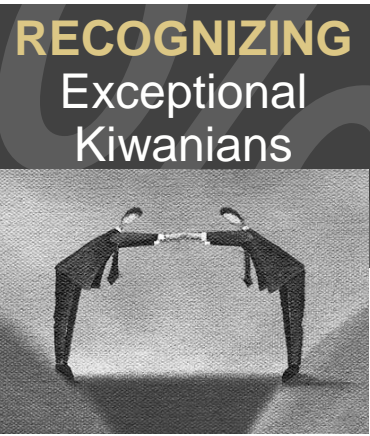
