Veteran’s Day.....

An Act approved May 13, 1938, made the 11th of November in each year a legal holiday—a day to be dedicated to the cause of world peace and to be thereafter celebrated and known as "Armistice Day." Armistice Day was primarily a day set aside to honor veterans of World War I, but in 1954, after World War II had required the greatest mobilization of soldiers, sailors, Marines and airmen in the Nation’s history and after American forces had fought aggression in Korea, the 83rd Congress, at the urging of the

veterans service organizations, amended the Act of 1938 by striking out the word "Armistice" and inserting in its place the word “Veterans”. With the approval of this legislation on June 1, 1954, Nov. 11th became a day to honor American veterans of all wars. Later that same year, on Oct. 8th, President Dwight D. Eisenhower issued the first "Veterans Day Proclamation" which stated: "In order to insure proper and widespread observance of this anniversary, all veterans, all veterans' organizations, and the entire citizenry will wish to join hands in this common purpose”.

 The Kiwanis general liability insurance program is not accident insurance. The insurance protects members, clubs, districts and Kiwanis International against legal liability, which generally accrues from a negligent act or failure to act, resulting in bodily injury to a person or damage to property.

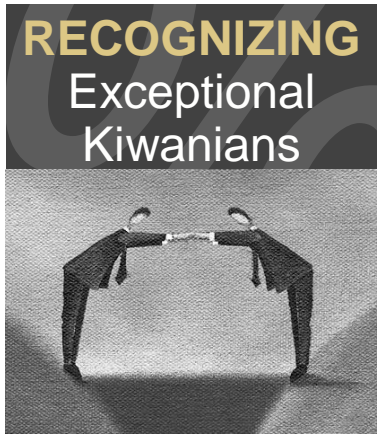
