## Looking back to look forward......

As our Kiwanis year comes to a close, it's a good time to look back on our activities so we can plan to make next year even better. This year we gave 5 new mini grants totaling \$2,450 and 7 community grants amounting to \$5,350. Along with these local grants, we helped Eliminate Maternal and Neonatal Tetanus with a \$5,379 donation and additionally contributing \$3,688 to the Florida and International Foundations. We didn't forget our Service Leadership Programs by helping them with \$5,783.

So, how could we afford to give away over \$22,650? A lot of dedicated workers, that's how. Selling Pancakes grossed \$18,990, working the Precinct gained us \$1,170, Parking Cars at Friday Fest paid \$1,400 and a new fundraiser at the Home & Garden Expo raised \$3,056 along with other Eliminate contributions. Thank you Kiwanians for your Service! These funds, and the many other service hours performed, benefitted thousands of children & families here and around the world. I am looking forward to doing more next year. Will YOU join me?

### Kiwanis College

The Kiwanis administrative year begins on Oct.1. Originally, clubs and districts operated on the calendar year. However, Kiwanis International officers were elected at the annual conventions in early summer and, until 1950, assumed office immediately. (In 1950, officers began taking office on August 1.) This led to many problems of budgeting, programming and leadership. For example, each international president worked with two sets of district governors and club presidents, and vice versa. In 1969, an administrative year that begins on Oct.1 was adopted for all levels of Kiwanis.


### **Setting an Example**
